MoMA puts collection inventories online

The Museum of Modern Art in New York has put inventories for its collections on its website. These guides to the museum's paper archives allow researchers to establish what materials are available for study before visiting in person. MoMA is among a handful of institutions pioneering the provision of this type of facility.
